Recovery Resource Council is seeking a full-time Master Level Director of Veteran Services to perform administrative and supervisory duties in support of Mental Health activities of the Enduring Families Veterans Services Program.

The ideal candidate has a minimum of five years of experience leading, evaluating, and supervising staff in a professional setting and three years of working with military and/or veteran populations in an outpatient mental health clinic or hospital environment. Lesser credentials and/or experience will be considered. Understands every stage of client service within a nonprofit psychotherapy clinic. Has experience with data input and collection and is able to perform formative and summative evaluations. Is knowledgeable of the intake, navigation, referral, and outreach processes. Is familiar with program contract requirements for both private and public grants. Creates an environment of accountability to performance standards for staff. Has knowledge and experience providing evidenced-based practice interventions to clients with mental and/or behavioral health issues such as coping with PTSD, depression, anxiety, stress, relational, personal, or family crisis, and/or other issues to help them reconnect as a family and improve their quality of life and overall functioning. Excels at developing and collaborating in the creation of individualized treatment plans which may include at least some of the following: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Cognitive Processing Therapy, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing, Systems Family Therapy, Prolonged Exposure, Child Centered Play Therapy, SandPlay Therapy, Gottman Couples Method, Emotionally Focused Therapy, Referral to Higher Levels of Care, and Family Support Services.

The selected candidate would have the following competencies

- Master's level degree or above in a mental health related field
- Must be a Texas fully licensed mental health psychotherapist in good standing (i.e., licensed professional counselor, licensed marriage and family therapist or licensed clinical social worker); supervisor a plus
- Military experience or knowledge of military / veteran culture
- Must have computer skills in Microsoft Office 365 (e.g., Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word, etc.). Must have experience or be willing to learn the following: Microsoft Access, One Drive, IBM SPSS Statistics Software, and Prezi
- Ability to supervise independently
- Strong communication skills including ability to deliver group presentations and trainings
- Skill in formulating treatment service plans and counseling goals and objectives
- Knowledge and experience working with the following treatment levels: individual, couples, family, and youth
- Knowledge and experience building community veteran resources a plus
- Knowledge and experience building of resources for mental health a plus
