This position provides services to high-risk teens in Denton, Johnson, Parker, Tarrant, Palo Pinto and Wise counties and currently offices from home with “Home Campus” assignment at the Fort Worth Campus.

Requirements: Bachelor’s Degree or equivalent experience required; Covid-19 vaccination card required; Must have prior experience working with youth and must possess strong skills in public speaking, classroom management, team-building and activity facilitation - including day camps, program marketing, professionalism, documentation, ethics, boundaries, initiative, and overall organizational skills; Prior experience providing prevention education is preferred; virtual and in-person classroom and service delivery will be required; additional on-job curriculum and prevention training required – including certification testing within first 18 months. Must demonstrate consistent commitment and success to “Making Meaningful Change” with both youth and adults while also upholding the agency Guarantee of “Unconditional Acceptance, Respect, and Positive Regard” for all.
